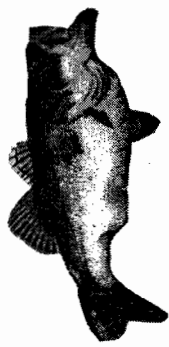

The Cambridge Lions Club has served our community for over 80 years. The earnings of this tournament will stay local and help support Lions Club projects such as eye examinations, eye glasses and diabetes support. The Lions Club sincerely thanks you for considering our tournament.

Tournament Rules:

1. Send in \$20 advance registration fee. Participants may be contacted by a committee member and/or notified of their boat number on the day of the event. Please pay the remaining balance in cash on day of event.
2. Entrants must be at least 18 years old. All boats must have an operating live well or aerated cooler that will be checked before the start of the tournament.
3. Participants release the Cambridge Lions Club, its individual members, and any individuals involved in this tournament on behalf of the Cambridge Lions Club from any and all liabilities and responsibilities.
4. No off limits. No more than two entrants per boat. Any additional rule questions will be answered at the registration table. Two fights over 40 boats. If necessary, fights will be 15 minutes apart. Tournament launches from Dam Ramp.
5. Only 5 bass per boat will be weighed. Only largemouth, smallmouth or spotted bass qualify. All fish must be 15 inches or longer and a courtesy board will be offered. All bass will be released once they are weighed. No culling at ramp. Weigh in will be at or near the ramp. Only one big bass per boat will be weighed. Fish will only be weighed from ramp, not from parking lot.
6. 8 ounce penalty for dead bass. Dead fish will be weighed. No short fish will be weighed. Late weigh-ins will be penalized one pound per minute and the boat will be disqualified after 15 minutes.
7. Entrants with boat problems are required to return with another competitor's boat.
8. Obey all no wake zones. Blocking of creeks, coves, etc., is not permitted. 50 foot separation required from anchored boats, however, participants are allowed to pass anchored boats.
9. Only artificial baits (including pork baits) are permitted. Fish must be hooked in a conventional manner. No snagging, netting, or trolling.
10. Alcohol and drugs are not permitted. Participants on prescription medication that may hinder their ability to operate a boat must notify the tournament officials prior to the start of the tournament.
11. All rulings and decisions of the tournament committee are final. Any protests must be made within 30 minutes after weigh-in. Any changes or modifications to these rules will be announced on the date of the tournament.
12. Unsportsmanlike conduct, disruptive behavior, or rule violations may result in disqualification from the tournament and future events.
